SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment to the bill. All it does is try and designate where the money that's collected for these permits will go. It also reduces the dollar amount of those permits from three to two dollars. So it's a technical amendment. I'd hope that you would approve it. I move its adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion and the second is to adopt the Wesely amendment to LB 146. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Yes, okay, 25 votes. Have you all voted? The motion is the Wesely...approval of the Wesely amendment to LB 146. Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.
