LB 17, 114A, 129

I move LB 129 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. We will have to pass over item #9, and move to General File. Are we ready for LB 114A?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President LB 114A was a bill introduced by Senator John DeCamp...(Read by title LB 114A.) The bill was first read on February 14. It was referred directly to General File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 114A to E & R for Review. Is there discussion? This is an A bill. All those in favor of advancing the...excuse me, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Well, I was just going to indicate that there will be a revision downward in this A bill by Select File probably about half of what it is indicated here, and... no, it can be advanced, John, to Select File. There's no reason to hold it, but I just wanted the members to know there would be a reduction. I thought maybe I ought to just briefly indicate that in workman's comp we do appropriate general fund, but it depends on the kind of an agency... usually from a one to a two year lag some reimbursement comes back to the general fund where a portion of the agency's cost is federal funds, cash funds or revolving fund, so even though it does require this amount at this point, or at this time, some portion of that will eventually be returned to the general fund.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing 114A to E & R for Review vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Senator Newell in the room? We're ready for LB 17. Senator Newell.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 17 was introduced by Senator David Newell of the 13th...(Read by title LB 17.) The bill was first read on January 4. It was referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments by Senator Carsten's Revenue Committee, Mr. President.
