SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Burrows votes no. Senator Clark votes... Senator Clark, did you vote? Senator Clark votes no.

CLERK: Senator Burrows voting no, Senator Clark voting no, Senator Brennan changing from yes to no, Senator Keyes voting no, Senator Marsh changing from no to yes, Senator Duis voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Clerk, announce... The Call is raised.
