SPEAKER MARVEL: Your time is up.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your time is up, Senator Venditte. The motion is the adoption of the Venditte proposed amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Now the Chair recognizes Senator Kelly. Do you want to read Senator Kelly's motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kelly moves to reconsider the Nichol amendment to LB 316 which can be found on page 620 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kelly, you have the floor.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, I would request... I need to enter this motion today because of the time element from yesterday and I have entered the motion and I respectfully request that we lay this motion over until tomorrow.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you mean your particular motion?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes. It has to be entered today or it would be out of time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You are proposed to enter the motion and then the bill will be advanced or at least the bill will be acted upon. So then if you want your....

SENATOR KELLY: Under this condition then we could withdraw this reconsideration motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I guess I... The Chair does not...

SENATOR KELLY: Well then the thing to do, Mr. Speaker, would be to take the motion up now.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think you need to take the motion up now. Act as rapidly as you can so we can get a vote on this amendment and also on the bill. Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I believe it can all be resolved here, hopefully prior to twelve o'clock. In the
