five or six out. I beg your pardon. The Chair is waiting your request to start whatever process you want to start. Are you requesting a Roll Call vote, or do you want a call in vote?

SENATOR LAMB: I'll request a Roll Call.

SENATOR LEWIS: There's two people not accounted for now, Senator Lamb. Alright, call the roll. Read the issue.

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendment offered by Senator Lamb reads as follows: (Read amendment.)

SENATOR LEWIS: You've heard the issue. Senator Lamb has requested a Roll Call vote. Proceed with the Roll Call.

CLERK: (Roll Call vote may be found on Pages 686 and 687 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LEWIS: Announce the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR LEWIS: Motion fails. We're back to the bill. Clear the board. Any other discussion on the bill. Senator Reutzel, what's your pleasure?

SENATOR REUTZEL: The advancement of the bill as amended.

SENATOR LEWIS: The motion is to advance LB 78 from General File to E & R. All in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Record your vote. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Lewis voting aye.

SENATOR LEWIS: Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

SENATOR LEWIS: The bill is advanced. Next bill, Mr. Clerk, according to the Speaker's orders, LB 434.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 434 was a bill introduced by the Constitution Revision and Recreation Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title LB 434.) The bill was first read on January 17th of this year. It was referred to the Constitutional Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments offered by Senator Reutzel's Committee.
