temporarily. We're working out some other amendments, and that might be part of the whole package. I'll withdraw that at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well let me...Senator Reutzel, do you want this temporarily passed over until the amendments are worked out, and then come back to it, or...or...what's your pleasure? I'll recognize you.

SENATOR REUTZEL: If I had my druthers, I'd rather adopt the Committee amendments and move it over and work on Select File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Alright.

SENATOR REUTZEL: I...Mr....am I closing on this then?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, I recognize you for closing on the Committee amendments.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I talked with Senator Lamb and Senator Schmit. I think we've got some language which we don't have right now, but we can very easily put it on Select File. We can move the bill over, and we can get to other matters. I have no objection to the amendments that Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb and I have talked about. I would move the adoption of the amendments. As far as what Senator Clark said, this does not prohibit you putting that rifle in the back of your pickup and driving from Omaha to Scottsbluff and back. You can...you can carry that rifle around in your pickup, in your Jeep, your RV...I don't care. All it prohibits is that man in the field hunting with that rifle without a deer permit during deer season. That's all it does. It enables the conservation officers to enforce the rules and regulations which this Legislature has already established, but which they are now powerless to enforce. And that's all it does, and I would work with Senator Lamb and Senator Schmit. I think we have an agreement already, but we just don't have...we don't have it typed up to amend it to everyone's satisfaction on Select File. I would move the adoption of the amendments and move it over.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 435. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 435. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk record.
