LB 435, 437

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are there any other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: I move the advancement of the bill as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance to E & R...advance 435 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance the bill. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced to E & R for Review. Now we go to LB 437, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 437 was introduced by the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee. (Read by title LB 437.) The bill was first read on January 17th and was referred to the Constitutional Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments offered by Senator Reutzel's Constitutional Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you move the adoption of the Committee amendments?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Yes, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to speak to them?

SENATOR REUTZEL: The amendments, as you can see in your bill book, are very simple. The word "with" is struck and inserted in its place is "when accompanied by". We just thought that was... would be clearer language. I move for their adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion on the Committee amendments to LB 437? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the Committee amendments to LB 437. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Committee amendments.
