

accepting the Fowler amendment, my amendments now should be withdrawn. The Fowler amendment is much superior to the amendments I would have. They are much narrower. They are much closer to being the correct way to handle the problems, and I very gladly withdraw both of my amendments to this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Both amendments are withdrawn. Senator Warner, we're now ready for the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I will then again move to advance LB 119 to E & R Initial. I think the discussion of the amendments has pretty well covered the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 119 as amended to E & R Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Motion carried...ah...Clerk record the vote. Sorry.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read...the motion is carried, and the bill is advanced. We're now ready for LB 66. Is there...go ahead. That's fine, but go ahead and read whatever is there.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 66 was introduced by Senator Robert Clark of the 47th. (Read by title LB 66.) The bill was first read on January 5. It was referred to the Public Works Committee. There are Committee amendments pending by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair will first of all recognize Senator Kremer.

SENATOR LEWIS: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: LB 66.

SENATOR LEWIS: LB 66, Committee amendments.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, LB 66 does have some Committee amendments. First of all, it's a rather simple bill. It...I should make this statement, it provides for a procedure for the dissolution of a solvent irrigation district. We already have on the statutes methods and ways, and means to dissolve an insolvent irrigation district and we have nothing about the solvent. Now what we do in the amendments is two things that provide for the emergency
