Mrs. Evelyn Love from here in Lincoln and her nephew, Matt Larson from Mitchell. I had the pleasure of meeting Matt this morning. Matt and Mrs. Love, will you stand up, under the South balcony. Welcome to your Legislature. Yes, Mr. Clerk, will you read these matters in?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance whose chairman is Senator DeCamp to whom is referred LB 200 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; 52 to General File with amendments; 180 to General File with amendments; 197 to General File with amendments; 220 to General File with amendments; 301 to General File with amendments; 334 to General File with amendments; 341 to General File with amendments, 478 to General File with amendments; 282 to General File with amendments, signed, Senator DeCamp, Chairman.

Mr. President, your committee on Public Works whose chairman is Senator Kremer to whom is referred LB 282 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments and 330 advanced to General File with amendments.
