LB 27, 84, 112, 287, 411

CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 734-735 of the Legislative Journal. 39 ayes, 1 nay, 7 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 287 passes with the emergency clause attached on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read the last bill on Final Reading for today, LB 411.

CLERK: Read LB 411 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 411 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 735-736 of the Legislative Journal. 40 ayes, 2 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 411 passes on Final Reading and that will conclude Final Reading today. We will now proceed to agenda Item #7, Select File. The Chair has been advised that in the...and with the permission of the Speaker, since Senator Kremer is absent that we would not take up LB 27 and 112. Speaker Marvel, would you care to address yourself?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, he had a little conflict with the ice and I was notified this morning, so he probably will be in tomorrow assuming he gets along all right. So then we need to pass over 27 and 112 and go to 84.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with LB 84. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 84.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 84. Is there any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 84 are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson now moves to amend. His amendments may be found on page 439 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Johnson.
