LB 84, 211

SENATOR JOHNSON: Mr. President, members of this body, as you may recall, LB 84 is a bill that, number one, shortens the time in tax foreclosure proceedings and, number two, raises the interest rate on delinquent taxes from 9% to 11%. The amendments that you find on page 439 of the Legislative Journal are amendments that will raise the interest rate from 9% to 11% as this body has previously agreed to, in two other sections. It seems as though when we drafted the bill and got it through committee we nonetheless missed two sections in which the interest rate was referred to. Thus, I put these two additional sections in the bill to make certain that the bill covers all tax delinquencies that presently exist in our statutes. I would appreciate your support.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, you didn't wish to speak to this, did you? Your light is on. Any further discussion? I guess, Senator Johnson, that will be your opening and closing. Motion is the adoption of the Johnson amendment to LB 84. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Legislative Journal page 439, the Johnson amendment is found on 439 of the Journal. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion passes. The Johnson amendment is adopted. Any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 84 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 84 to E & R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 84 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. We will proceed then next to LB 211. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 211 was placed on Select File with amendments. The amendments were adopted on February 28. Senator Keyes on February 28th made a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill. That motion laid over. We are now ready to take that up.
