SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 297 to E & R for review. Is there any further discussion? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no on the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Next, LB 105. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 105. Read title. The bill was read on January 8th of this year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Carsten's Revenue Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. The committee amendments are amendments that were suggested by Senator Cullan when he presented the bill. They are literally a clarification amendment and what the amendment does was it would say all factors taken into consideration when distributing the value from railroads. Heretofore there were two explanations originally and there was some cloudiness on what density factors and so forth were. This is just merely calling for all factors to be used in that distribution. I move for the adoption of the committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Revenue Committee amendments to LB 105. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendments to LB 105, committee amendments. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendments are adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan to discuss the bill as amended.
