SENATOR KEYES: Yes, as we're advancing this bill, now how many subdivisions of government is my County Treasurer going to have to send a notice to?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Who are you directing the question to?

SENATOR KEYES: Senator...I believe Senator Murphy said something on that...he knows how many...

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Murphy, with your amendment, you have just put probably one more person to work in counties of fifty thousand, and in counties of a hundred thousand you probably have one or two more people on the payroll. You have taken away a source of revenue that would hire these people with money that rightfully belongs to the county until the school decides to spend it, until the NRD decides to spend it, and the NRD says I need one hundred thousand dollars, no more, no less.
