Mr. President, I have three Attorney General's opinions, the first addressed to Senator Carsten regarding LB 285, the second to Senator Carsten, again on 285 and the third to Senator Lamb regarding LB 119. SPEAKER MARVEL: Is that all on #4? Senator Wesely, are you ready for item #5 which is the adoption of E & R amendments for three separate bills?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I move the E & R amendments for LB 159.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to 159 say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Now we advance the bill again.

SENATOR WESELY: I move to readvance LB 159.

SPEAKER MARVEL: To E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR WESELY: For E & R engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 316.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 316.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move to readvance LB 316 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of readvancing the bill say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is readvanced. LB 84.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 84.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Now what do we do with the bill, Senator Wesely?
