LB 84, 316

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move to readvance LB 84 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bills are re-advanced. Thank you, sir. We now go to special order #6 which has to do with specific motions for LB 316. Senator Koch, are you ready for your motion? The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp. You have two amendments to LB 316.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I need a page to pass these out but they are all out getting coffee. Yes, this is a substitute. Now don't panic. This is not a rewrite of the bill. What I am doing is putting the bill in a white copy so you can read it in its final form and that is done so you don't have to piece things together. I thought it would just be convenient since we are this far along.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, do you want to withdraw the two that you have in the Journal?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What page in the Journal, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, he had two, one on 709 and 739.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, do you ask unanimous consent to withdraw the two motions, one on page 709 and the other on page 739?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection? If not, so ordered.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, incredible as it seems, the few amendments I am going to offer are noncontroversial and technically corrective and that is all. You remember reading the Attorney General's opinion. In a couple of areas he said this word was wrong or that word was wrong or this was a little vague. Just trying to correct those areas so that there is no problem. So where we had the one problem he said we don't know what unemancipated means because it is not described in the statutes. We simply say, minor child under the age or minor child. Now it is my understanding Senator Hoagland wants to say minor child under the age of eighteen. I will accept that. That is fine. He can put that amendment to this amendment. Oh, well, we can get to that, yes. We can get it changed later
