

you said that there were no penalty provisions for confidentiality and, Senator Dworak, I guess this answers the question, your question, relative to confidentiality and if you will look on page 8, lines 3 through 8, in 2661 and, members of the Legislature, I know that you have heard this. This is its third, its fourth and its fifth time, but it is important. The issue here is extremely important. It is important to me and I am sure it is important to you. Confidentiality is given to the woman here. It says, "no person shall disclose any information contained on the written consent or the statement of consultation including the identity of the woman seeking the abortion" and it goes on and, members of the Legislature, that again is reaffirmed on page 10, section 9, lines 16 through 18 where it says, "The abortion reporting form required under this section shall not include the name of the person upon whom the abortion is being performed." What more do you want? And yet, no one here has said the doctor has the right to privacy. Senator DeCamp, Senator John, you are disgusting and untrusting. Senator John says, the reason why I am doing this is so that we can pick on these doctors. Ladies and gentlemen, there were five thousand abortions performed in this state last year. Did any one in here pick on those doctors? Who in here picked on one of those doctors who performed the five thousand abortions? And Senator John with his empty rhetoric says we want this information so we can pick on these people. This is important to me, this legislation as I am sure the death penalty is to Senator Chambers, as I am sure the infraction system is to Senator John. I hope that when we make this decision on this amendment, we know what we are doing. Senator Hoagland knows what he is doing. You can bet Senator Johnson knows what he is doing but do the rest of us know what we are doing?
