SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Now, Mr. Clerk, I have two groups of people to introduce and then we will go to Senator Koch's motion. In the North balcony from Senator Sieck's district, twenty-eight students from the St. John Lutheran School in Seward, David Manigold the teacher. Let's give them a hand over here in the North balcony. Underneath the South balcony from Senators Cope and Kahle's districts, seven Buffalo County Farm Bureau young farmers and ranchers and we welcome you to the Legislature, the ladies and gentlemen over here underneath the South balcony. Now the Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, the Clerk has my motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Will you read the motion, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I understand that ...

SENATOR KOCH: First of all, Mr. Speaker, I would withdraw the amendment that I had printed in the Journal and I have resubmitted an amendment that the Clerk has on his desk.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first motion is ...

SENATOR KOCH: Ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment that was printed in the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection to the unanimous consent request? If not, so ordered. Now, Mr. Clerk.
