LB 316, 17

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent that the LB 316 be expedited. I would like to advise the body the matter in the court comes up Wednesday and it is the hope of both sides that the legislation could be passed prior to that time so that could be taken into the court.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I would suggest that Senator DeCamp carefully consider the amendments they adopted this morning before they expedite the bill but if you do expedite it, I am not going to bring this up until after you pass it but before the Governor signs it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The unanimous request...there has been no objection, so ordered. We are now ready to go to Select File. The first bill up is Select File. What is the status of LB L7?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 17.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to move the E & R amendments to LB 17.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me?
