particularly care to have that in there. It seems to me it might generate more requests for expenditures when in fact there wasn't. My only concern was that if we were going to ask them to perform responsibilities and collect information which they do not now provide or are not now required to accumulate, then I was concerned about the cost but if it is merely reporting the figures that they normally acquire, then I see no problem or no need to worry about reimbursement.

SENATOR NEWELL: Well you were the primary person who was concerned about that so on that basis I will withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR NEWELL: I do.
