LB 434, 437, 119

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendment to LB 434.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move LB 434 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 437.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 437 be advanced to E & R for engrossment for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, are there amendments to 119?

CLERK: Yes, sir. There are E & R amendments as well as others pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 119.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to 119. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried, the amendment is adopted. Now do you have others?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb moves to amend LB 119. Would you like me to read those, Senator?

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Mr. Clerk, I had one amendment in the Journal which I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw, please. The amendment that I am speaking to now is one which I circulated this morning. You have a copy on your desk, amendment to LB 119. This amendment is aimed at the situation which we recently saw in the Omaha Public Power District and the Nebraska Public Power District contract situation, the cancellation of the Fort Calhoun plant.
