CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Proceed then with the next item on the agenda on motions, item #6, but the Clerk would like to read some things in first so proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, one new bill, LB 14A introduced by Senator Nichol. Title read.

Mr. President, I have a series of Attorney General's opinions. The first is addressed to Senator Duis regarding Rule 1 relating to the Board of Examiners in Embalming. Attorney General #50 addressed to Senator Carsten, and a third addressed to Senator Kremer regarding LB 26, Mr. President. All three will be inserted in the Legislative Journal. PRESIDENT: Now on to agenda item #6, Senator Kelly is not present on LR 21 and neither is Senator Newell so we will proceed to the pending matter. Just at ease. The Speaker has requested a change in his order, has announced a change in his order, and unless there is an objection at this point, we will proceed to Select File and complete Select File before we return to the motions because of the absence of some of the people handling these matters. Is there any objection to the Speaker's order? So ordered then and we will then proceed with Select File, agenda item #7, LB 297. Is Senator Wesely present? Senator Nichol, would you handle Select File for us? The Vice Chairman is not here. You are Vice Chairman so we will go to you.

SENATOR NICHOL: If you will help me?

PRESIDENT: All right. LB 297. Are there any E & R Amendments?

CLERK: There are no E & R amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: So just move it on, then.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move that LB 297 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.
