Senator Rumery, is he under the North balcony? Would Mr. Cox please stand up, all right, right in the back of the room? Welcome, Mr. Cox. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, are you taking call in votes?

PRESIDENT: Yes, we will take call in votes.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay, I change from nay to aye in order to get this off the Board.

PRESIDENT: Senator Newell voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Newell changing from no to yes. Senator Goodrich voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan is voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Cullan is voting aye, changing from no to yes. Senator Schmit changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson changing.

CLERK: Senator Johnson changing from no to yes. Senator Cope changing from no to yes. Senator Dworak changing from no to yes. Senator Fitzgerald changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: All right.

CLERK: Senator Keyes changing from no to yes. Senator Rumery changing from no to yes. Senator Burrows changing
