better, and if you do get better, the county assessor, he is allowed to make those determinations and he can do that with doctor statements and so forth. So it makes this bill, LB 65, the same as LB 6 and LB 76 which have already been signed by the Governor and already law.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the adoption of the Newell amendments to the committee amendments to LB 65. All those in favor...all right, all those in favor of the Newell amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Newell amendment to the Revenue Committee amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Newell's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. We are now ready for a motion to advance the bill to E & R as amended. Senator Carsten makes the motion. All those in favor of advancing LB 65 as amended vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Senator Lewis, excuse me, Mr. Clerk. LB 441.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 441. Title read. The bill was read on January 17th. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Newell's Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, committee amendments.

SENATOR NEWELL: I move the advancement of the committee amendment. It is an amendment that basically says, when Frank Lewis wrote the bill, he asked for more than he needed. So then he came back in committee and said that this section wasn't necessary and everybody agreed with him so we all agreed that we'd let Frank have his amendment.
