SENATOR KEYES: Senator Maresh, I want you to take it as no... nothing toward you, but I think if the Governor wants a bill introduced, the Governor can introduce it himself.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the introduction of Request #820? Hearing none, Senator Maresh, I presume that was your closing. Senator Maresh, that was your closing. The question before the House is the introduction of Request #820 to introduce a new bill. It will require 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to introduce, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is introduced. The Clerk may read the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 581 introduced by the Business and Labor Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title for the first time LB 581. See Page 843 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: We will proceed then with Final Reading. The Sergeant at Arms will see to it that all members are at their desks, that all nonlegislative personnel are off the floor. We are on Final Reading, and while we are doing this, the Chair will explain to those in the galleries that at Final Reading all members are to be at their desks. There is no debate, and pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, it is required that every word of every bill be read at this stage of the legislative procedure, and so at this time when all the members have taken their places at their desks we will proceed with Final Reading. So as soon as the conference breaks up back there we will start. We are now ready to proceed with Final Reading as soon as our Chairman of the Exec Board has found his place. He now has. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 215.

CLERK: (Read LB 215.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, "Shall LB 215 pass with the emergency clause attached?" All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you
