CLERK: (Read LB 90.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall LB 90 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 9 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Pages 844 and 845 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 90 passes on Final Reading. We will now...the Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 90A.

CLERK: (Read LB 90A.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 90A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Simon, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SIMON: Just a question, Mr. President. It was my understanding that all A bills were going to be held up. Is that correct, or incorrect?

PRESIDENT: The answer is that it's only general fund A bills that are being held. This is not...does not constitute...

SENATOR SIMON: Thank you, sir.

PRESIDENT: Proceed then with the vote. Record the vote.
