SPEAKER MARVEL: If there's no objection...Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Well, Senator Schmit, let me offer some other possibilities. Since we're on this bill, there may be other amendments, Mr. President, and I think the easiest way with a full understanding here is that if we can clear it up now, down to this one specific amendment, then we could move it over and then retrieve it so that we've got that process over with with codifying all the other amendments. I don't know if that's satisfactory. If it isn't, Senator Schmit, I'll withdraw any temporary objections I have.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Senator DeCamp has a word to say.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator...Senator Schmit, we're still on your time. Do you want to ask Senator DeCamp another question?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would just say this, that from my point of view, there are issues to be dealt with in the bill, and I think that perhaps...I'll ask Senator DeCamp how long it takes to get this thing put together, but I would believe it might be well to use the rest of our time this morning, although I don't think we can move that bill in twenty minutes, Senator Lewis. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, so everybody understands now, Frank, if we move the bill...if we move the bill as Senator Schmit has written it, I am guessing that it makes multitudes of schools and other political subdivisions in violation of the lid bill, because some of them would have operated on the three year average. Okay, so, it's fine by me, whichever way we go with the complete and total understanding on the part of everybody that we do have to do something with respect to Senator Carsten's amendment. So, I think that's a fundamental understanding that everybody has to have. You've got to do something, or we've created another quagmire. So, maybe...whatever way you want to go.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Alright, let me ask this question. Mr. Clerk, are there other amendments to LB 26 on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, there are. There are two.

SPEAKER MARVEL: And who are the authors of those?

CLERK: Senator Vickers has an amendment. Senator Kelly has an amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do they deal...Senator Kelly, does yours deal with Senator Carsten's amendment?
