SENATOR KELLY: Negative.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Vickers. Well, the Chair is going to propose this, that Senator Carsten and Senator DeCamp, and others who are interested in the proposed Carsten amendment please proceed underneath the balcony and see what you can come up with before we adjourn. Meanwhile I will proceed with the other amendments to LB 26. Now, Senator Dworak, you... your light was on. Do you want to address yourself to...well we have...we're going to take up Vickers and Kelly. Do you have another amendment? Or do you want to speak to...

SENATOR DWORAK: I wanted to talk to Senator Carsten's amendment, which is before us now, but since they're moving to talk about this, I'll wait to see if they can get that worked out.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Alright. Senator Vickers, you had... well, while they're in conference, underneath the south balcony it's my privilege to introduce one of the bosses of Senator Venditte, and this lady lives a few blocks from Senator Labeledz, Senator Venditte's Polish mother-in-law, Mary Novacheck. Will you please stand so we may say hello to you? Was that, Senator Venditte...Senator Venditte, was that pronunciation close? Thank you. Senator Vickers, do you wish to take up your amendment to LB 26?

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, I would request to pass over my amendment until we can determine what happens with the Carsten amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Kelly, do you wish to take up your amendment now?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, please, Mr. Speaker.
