PRESIDENT: All right, the motion...

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel moves to suspend Rule 6, Section 6b so as to take up LB 25, 78, 81, 133, 140, 146, 316, 323, 434 and 474 on Final Reading today. That is signed by the Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I so move. There are several noncontroversial bills in the group and I think that we can suspend the rules and spend the next couple of hours on these bills.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion on the motion to suspend the rules in order that we might take up for Final Reading all the bills on your agenda item #5, 25 through 474?
