Would they just be recognized please over here, the Roits. Welcome to your Legislature. If all members will return to their desks we will commence with Final Reading. We are waiting for all legislators to be at their desks so we can commence Final Reading. As the Speaker said the session is half over today and as one of your colleagues said this morning, it is all downhill from here on out so...the Speaker I am not sure agrees. Are you ready? Ready to go? Not all ready. If Senator Merz will get to his chair we will start. Under the South balcony I have Ron Milner, NRD manager from Imperial. Mr. Milner, will you stand up while we are waiting for everybody to sit down. Thank you. Welcome to your Legislature. I believe everybody is at their desk. We will commence then, Mr. Clerk, with the reading of LB 211 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 211 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 211 pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 870-871 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 19 ayes, 24 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 211 having failed to receive the necessary votes for the emergency clause fails on this vote so the question now is, shall LB 211 pass without the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 871 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 17 ayes, 26 nays, 3 excused and not voting and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
