SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 881 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill passes with the emergency clause attached. The next bill on Final Reading is LB 434. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: (Read LB 434 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 881-882 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions having been complied with, the bill is declared passed. The final bill on Final Reading, LB 474. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: (Read LB 474 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of the law having been complied with, the question is, shall 474 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 882-883 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and
