LB 27

SPEAKER MARVEL: May I have the attention of Senator Sieck and Senator Maresh. The motion is that the bill, LB 27 be sent back to Public Works. Now you and Senator Maresh both have amendments and the amendments will have to be at least temporarily withdrawn if this motion is acted upon. Okay, Senator Sieck, do you...?

SENATOR SIECK: I yield to Senator Kremer. I understand that Senator Maresh's bill is similar to mine only it would just delete (mike not activated)...so I will agree with Senator Kremer that we send this back to Public Works.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair will rule this way that it was Senator Sieck's request, if it is carried out we will then be prepared to act upon your motion.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, could I change my motion and ask for unanimous consent? It might shorten this thing up.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We still have to get the withdrawal of Senator Sieck's motion. Pardon?

SENATOR SIECK: I will withdraw my motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Sieck asks unanimous consent to withdraw his motion to LB 27. Is there any objection? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Kremer asks unanimous consent that the bill be returned to Public Works and I think we are going to have a vote on this. Do you so move?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Chair recognizes Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, we discussed this bill on General File. We discussed this bill on Select File and I think that we are making a mistake in taking bills that have gone this far through the process. The committee that has heard the bill, to put it back and go over it again. I don't see anything to be gained by that and in light of Senator Kremer's request, since it is his bill, I will withdraw my objections but I think we had better be careful about continually referring things back and moving backward. I think we could either amend the bill here so it is proper or kill it. I think this is a mistake but I do withdraw my objections.
