the appropriation that was in the regular bill plus LB 965 which was a deficiency bill, that was \$1,230,000 leaving a present deficit of \$1,103,000. In addition to that, you see some estimated bills that have not as yet been submitted but is anticipated by the military department of \$255,000. This is then with the additional million dollars, it is anticipated that there would be a balance of \$200,000 at the end of the fiscal year. I should also point out that the regular appropriation bill request was for a half a million for next year, and if all these projections hold up, then there would be an amount of approximately \$700,000 in the Governor's emergency fund for fiscal year '79-'80. If there are other questions on it, I would be glad to answer as to the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 577. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Warner, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move the bill be advanced. In addition to the two dollar amounts that I indicated, the bill also carries a language correction for LB 965 of last session with dealt with \$100,000. That \$100,000 is included in the amounts we have here now but there was a language change that was needed for the authorization of the expenditure of \$100,000 for repair of what I think is called "Hansen's Lake" area for a dike that was damaged in the flood last year and that language correction is also contained in LB 577 in addition to the dollar amount.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the advancement of the bill as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote. Excuse me, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: When the vote is announced, Mr. President, I just wanted to ask to have it expedited because there are these outstanding bills that cannot be processed until the bill is enacted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.
