Have you all voted?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, if I could have a Call of the House. I intend to bring the bill back anyway for another amendment but we have to get it advanced before we can bring it back.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The request is for a Call of the House. The Clerk will clear the Board. All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, record.
