the statute. So we are just dealing with the penalty here, be sure the penalty does apply with this added length but the same as with weight. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you wish to be recognized on the Kremer amendments?

SENATOR CULLAN: Are these the amendments, I am sorry I was on the phone, on the fertilizer equipment, Senator Kremer?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, sir, in LB 112 we are dealing with...an explanation was made with the length of truck the other day. Now in answering your question, I will have to go right to the content of the amendment itself but here we are dealing only with a penalty that needs to be placed in this bill as it applies to the lengthening of the trucks to 65 feet. So we are bringing weight into this bill and we are providing a penalty for overweight.

SENATOR CULLAN: You have other amendments that are forthcoming with respect to fertilizer (interruption) and so forth.

SENATOR KREMER: That is right.

SENATOR CULLAN: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: These amendments, Senator Cullan, are on page 619.

SENATOR KREMER: And they apply only to the length of trucks we talked on before. It does not apply to the other amendment that I have up there that would consider legislation dealing with the Big A or the fertilizer spreader.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, do you wish to be recognized on the Kremer amendments?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Senator Kremer, if I could ask a question, will you yield?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, sir.

SENATOR WESELY: I haven't been able to follow real closely your explanation on the amendment and I am just assuming, and I want you to confirm this, that all you are trying to
