LB 102, 105, 114, 114A

Senator Bernice wasn't here at the time, so I thought I'd better get it up there. The bill drafter left out a sentence, or a line in a sentence, or something. That's all it is. It puts in the left out words.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Senator Labeledz, do you have anything?

SENATOR LABEDZ: No, other than I support his amendment.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Motion is to return for the purpose of... return to Select File for the purpose of amendment. No further discussion. Senator DeCamp, that will conclude your closing then. All those in favor of returning LB 102 for the amendment proposed by Senator DeCamp vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is returned to Select File. Proceed back on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk. You will read on Final Reading LB 105. Mr. Speaker, is that right, you want to wait for Select File to take that matter up, and proceed with Final Reading, rather than...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Alright, sir. Proceed on LB 105.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 105.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 105 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The vote is 36 ayes, 6 nays, 4 excused and not voting, and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Page 927 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 105 passes on Final Reading. At this time the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel regarding the next bill or two.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I would ask that we pass over LB 114 and 114A. I have discussed this with those interested in...directly interested in this legislation. 114 has the A bill, 114A, and we passed a motion in here that all the A bills will be held until they're all gathered together. So I would like to move from 105 down to 119.
