CLERK: Mr. President, the amendment reads as follows: "To amend LB 19, excuse me... to amend LB 94 on Page 19, in lines 4 and 5 strike the new language, and reinstate the stricken matter in lines 5 through 9."

21 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President. (Roll call vote may be found on Page 935 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion fails. The Call is raised. Senator Cullan, do you wish to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, Mr. President, it would be nice to advance LB 94 to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 94 from Select File to E & R for Engrossment. I'm sorry, from General File to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that the House go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, clear the Board. The question before the House, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Clerk record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 2 nays to under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The House is under Call. Once again all legislators please return to their seats and record their presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The House is under Call. Please return to your seats. Record your presence. If anybody wants to call in their vote, they're accepted. Senator Chambers, do you want to record your presence? Senator Marsh, do you want to record your presence, please? Senator Brennan, do you want to record your presence?

CLERK: Senator Merz voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: While we're waiting for the Sergeant at Arms to bring in Senator Schmit, Senator Hasebroock, Senator DeCamp, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Cope, will you record your presence, please? There are five absent, right? We're looking for four.
