LB 269

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 269. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 269 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. There is an amendment on the desk and I see that Senator Wesely has arrived so he can take over.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh moves to amend LB 269, in committee amendment strike 1980 and insert 1981.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh. The Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, some of the small banks were concerned about having checks ordered, the old check blanks and they would like to postpone the enactment date of this for a year. I talked to the various people that have an interest in this bill, Senator Hasebroock and the banking industry and they do support this amendment. So I move that this be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, it is fine.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock, would you care to...?

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: I have no objection to the amendment. I think it would give the banks a chance to get their house in order and get rid of their old supply of check blanks.

PRESIDENT: I think it was nice that Senator Maresh got to bring up the matter of checks again this morning, so that is a real good... Any other discussion? All those in favor then of adopting the amendment to LB 269 by Senator Maresh vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.
