LB 108

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Next item is LB 108. What is the status of 108, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 108 was placed on Select File. I have amendments pending by, first of all, Senator Brennan. Would you like me to read those, Senator? Okay.

SENATOR BRENNAN: I wish to withdraw temporarily those amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendments?

SENATOR BRENNAN: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. How many amendments do you have, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Two others, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lewis now moves to amend and his amendments are on page 640 of the Journal.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, first of all, Pat, I would like to withdraw those amendments and resubmit a refinement of the same amendment and the page has one. She will deliver that to the Clerk now. So I would ask permission to withdraw that amendment and substitute the one that is coming up and the bill was recommended by the bill drafters, not to change the substance at all.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want to withdraw the amendment that is found on page 640?

SENATOR LEWIS: Yes, and resubmit, Mr. President, the one that I just gave the Clerk and the one that is now being passed out to all the members. May I proceed with that amendment now, Mr. President?

SPEAKER MARVEL: First of all, Senator Lewis asks unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment to 108 found on page 640. Is there any objection? If not, so ordered.

SENATOR LEWIS: Now I want to resubmit this one in its place, Mr. President, and it does the same thing except
