LB 66 and 435

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. LB 435 is advanced to E & R Engrossment. LB 66. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 66.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 66. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 66 are adopted. Any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Clark moves to amend LB 66 in line 1, Section 3, Page 5, after the word "A" insert "legal".

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President and members, all this is is putting a legal newspaper in instead of just a newspaper. The newspapers came around and wanted that put in, so I said I would do it. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Alright, any further discussion of the Clark amendment to LB 66? Seeing none, Senator Clark I guess that will be your close. All those in favor of adopting the amendment to LB 66 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We're voting on the Clark amendment to LB 66. Have you all voted on the Clark amendment on LB 66? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Clark's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The Clark amendment is adopted. Anything else on the bill? Mr. Clerk, is there any other amendment?

CLERK: No, sir, I have nothing else.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Senator Wesely.
