LB 348

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read the amendment? Is the amendment on the Clerk's desk, Senator Simon?

SENATOR SIMON: Yes, it is. Let me just explain what the amendment to the committee amendments does. On the committee amendments in line 2 strike all the language where it says "strike" beginning with "state", strike all that through the end of line six and then insert new language which would say that there will be a sign which shall state "See owner for cost of towing and location where the vehicle may be found." This is the same intent as the committee amendment but it is much more clearly defined. I move for adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, you are moving adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR SIMON: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Simon amendment to the committee amendments to LB 348. All those in favor of adoption of the Simon amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote. This is just a simple majority.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted and we are now voting on the committee amendments as amended, and that is to LB 348. Senator Clark, do you wish to have the floor? We are voting on the committee amendments first. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments as amended vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments as amended to LB 348. We are voting on the committee amendments as amended. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is adopted. The committee amendments are approved. Senator Clark, do you wish to...Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: I will just very briefly discuss the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR SIMON: With the passage of the criminal code that
