SENATOR MURPHY: Maybe we could pick it up on Select File.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, or I think legislative intent, this is on record now and I think that alone should give them direction that this should be done through the mail. The NRD should know this by you saying it in on the record. That should provide guidance for them.

SENATOR MURPHY: You have faith, Senator Maresh, and I admire you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 213 to E & R for review as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. Bill is advanced. LB 509.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 509. Title read. The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending. Senator Hoagland, as I understand it, has an amendment to the committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Hoagland, I recognize you for your amendment.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: We have had some confusion here, Mr. Speaker. On Exhibit A to the handout that has just come around is the amendment that the committee in fact adopted. Now the committee report does not accurately reflect the fact that this amendment was adopted. What is shown as Exhibit A is to completely replace the bill as currently written. So at this time, I would move that Exhibit A be adopted as my amendment to the committee amendment and the package be adopted then to replace the bill as currently written.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the Hoagland amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Hoagland's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, Senator Hoagland, do you want to discuss the committee amendment as amended?
