There are seizures that people who are diabetic can have too and I don't see where the welfare of these children, Senator Labeledz, should have such a low rung on the ladder of our priorities that they should be ignored and disregarded. I ask that at least twenty five of the people of that twenty nine who voted to consider LB 63 would vote to adopt this amendment and, Mr. Chairman, I would ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.
