SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Next item is LB 425 and this was returned for a specific amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 425 had been correctly engrossed. Senator Simon made a motion to return to Select File and that motion prevailed. We now have before us the Simon amendment which may be found on page 911 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Simon on the specific amendment.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, members of the body, this amendment was discussed the other day. This is permissive language which would allow the local school board, if they wanted to, to be able to pay additional monies for the second, third, fourth, et cetera, kids of each family. It is my understanding that Senator Lamb, I don't want to put words in your mouth, but it is my understanding I have another amendment on this that Senator Lamb wanted which I will offer and it is my understanding that, Senator Lamb, you have no opposition then to the bill with these two amendments attached? Is that correct? It was the other day. Anyway, there shouldn't be any opposition to the amendment. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Simon, you are asking to withdraw your specific amendment then...

SENATOR SIMON: No, no, I am not. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

CLERK: On page 848?

SENATOR SIMON: Yes.

CLERK: Do you want that amendment, Senator?

SENATOR SIMON: Yes.
