SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Legislature will come to order. Please record your presence. Senator Cullan, do you want to indicate your presence? Senator Cullan and Senator Newell, would you indicate your presence, please? Quorum's present.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: First, we'll just go down the line on the consent calendar. The next bill is LB 74.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 74 was a bill introduced by the Ag and Environment Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title LB 74.) The bill was first read on January 5. It was referred to the Ag and Environment Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments pending by Senator Schmit's Ag and Environment Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: It's LB 74, Committee amendments. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, does anybody else want to handle this bill? Senator Burrows. He's not here. Senator Schmit. He's not here. Well this is a bill dealing with gasohol, and it would require the use of gasohol in the state cars when it became available. The theory is that some day we're going to build a plant, and when and if we do, then this would guarantee that the state would endorse the concept by utilizing it itself. So...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move the Committee amendments?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, I'll do that too. I think that they say...well, I don't know what they say, but I'll read them. Oh, yes. The amendments say, alcohol "produced in Nebraska". I suggested that to the Committee that maybe we ought to have that in there. Now I don't know whether it's right or not, but I thought it was at the time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 74. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is on the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 74, which is the next bill on your consent calendar. Senator Koch, do you wish to be
