SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. The next one is 321.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 321 was introduced by the Ag and Environment Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read LB 321.) The bill was first read on January 16. It was referred to the Ag and Environment Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments pending by the Ag and Environment Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes would like to have members of the Government and Military Affairs Committee meet for three minutes underneath the north balcony, right away. Senator Lamb, do you want to handle the Ag Committee amendments?

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB 321 is a bill that was introduced at the request of the Department of Environmental Control, and I would move the Committee amendments, which are technical in nature and correct the title.
