LB 412, 447

We have another amendment to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brennan moves to amend on Page 5, line 11, insert "reasonable" after the word "awarded", and on Page 5, line 15, strike the comma after the word "section" and insert a period. Strike the remainder of line 15 and line 16 and 17.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment because the sponsor doesn't want it. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, unanimous consent has been requested to withdraw the amendment. Hearing no objections, so ordered. Senator Landis, we have about one minute left. Do you wish to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: No, I wish to move to indefinitely postpone LB 447.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to indefinitely postpone 447. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is indefinitely postponed. We now go to LB 412 introduced by the Government Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 412 was a bill introduced by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. It's a bill for an act to amend...(Read LB 412.) The bill was first read on January 17 of this year. It was referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments pending by the Government Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We will take up the Committee amendments first. Senator Keyes, do you wish to adopt the Committee amendments?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I do. Well, Mr. Speaker and fellow senators, and I hope that most of the senators on the floor of the Legislature now listen to this bill. This is a bill that is mandated by LB257 commonly called the Sunset Law. We either pass this bill, or else I understand that the Office of Planning and Programming will go out of existence.
