or attempt to, and then the bill goes to the bottom of the pile.

SENATOR DUIS: Well, I'm certinly sorry, I apologize to Senator Schmit if I didn't come over and visit with him about my amendments personally. But these particular amendments will do away with the review of hospital authorities. It will do away with the distribution of local subdivisions. It will do away with the six-year development plans, and that whole ball of wax. It's very necessary that this be adopted as an amendment to the amendments, and I would sincerely hope that the members of this Legislature would read the amendments to 412. And I do want you to know that we have done away with most of the duties of the Programming and Planning Department. We have funneled them into the new department so that the Governor of the State of Nebraska will have a collecting agency that will be able to get all that information into one place so that it could be taken to his office instead of going to each one of these departments for all of their...find out about their federal funds and all that sort of thing. So I would ask the adoption of the amendment to the Committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Duis amendment to the committee amendments to LB 412. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the Duis amendment to the Committee amendments. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Duis' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendments are adopted. The fifteen minute time limit is up, so we will cease debate on this issue, and we will go to LB 500. This is a Government... oh, excuse me, Mr. Clerk, will you bring us up to date on LB 500?

CLERK: Yes, sir. LB 500 was introduced by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. (Read LB 500.) The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Government Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Keyes' Government Committee.
