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much more time on Select File when the other amendments are filed. So I would urge the body to reject the Committee amendments, and move the bill over to Select File, because this is going to take some time, and I think it's going to be much clearer for everyone if we do...if we proceed in this fashion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, do you wish to be recognized now?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, I just echo what Senator Reutzel said, with the understanding that Senator Reutzel and I think Senator Nichol, and maybe some of the people that worked on the bill...it really is kind of a major bill and it's going to save the state some money, and it's going to make our jury system a lot more efficient. It hasn't been functioning well. People get called in. They sit on their duffs for a day, and then they get sent home. Counties have to spend money. It's a device that arose initially out of a desire to save money, believe it or not, so if we could move the bill without the Committee amendments, I think maybe there are a couple areas where we can work on Select File and have it straightened out, and I hope Bill would go along with that. Is that okay?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, no I wouldn't go along with that...

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay.

SENATOR NICHOL: ...because I think the bill is better with the Committee amendments, but I do not object to your working on the amendments as we go along. The only way... with the bill without the Committee amendments, I'd hate to see it go on by that way. So I don't have any objection to your working on the amendments, of course. Why don't we adopt the amendments and then work on them as we go along? Would that be okay?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Barry, go ahead and say something.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Senator Nichol, we can do that, except we don't have all the specific amendments worked out, and it's going to take a lot of time and we're only allotted fifteen minutes, and this is what we're working against today, and I think rather than go through...we can stall this, but I don't want to do that, but we can argue every one of the Committee amendments now, to reject the amendments,
