not part of that compromise, and for that reason I forgive him for those remarks that he made, but on the other hand, there are others who were parties to the compromise. Now the compromise is gone and I went back and talked to members of my committee who I was trying to defend in this compromise and they are no longer as steadfastly in support of the compromise as they were. Now that sometimes happens and we all understand that happens. Now I am not necessarily one who is going to get out of step with the members of my committee, so for that reason I would ask that the amendment be withdrawn since those who made the compromise no longer can remember it or are no longer anxious to keep it, and for that reason if I could withdraw the amendment, I think we could move to the bill. Do I have to ask unanimous consent or can I just withdraw the amendment?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Unanimous consent has been requested by Senator Newell to withdraw his amendment to the committee amendments. Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. Okay, the motion now is to adopt the committee amendments as amended. Now, Senator Fitzgerald, do you wish to talk to this motion? Senator Keyes, do you wish to talk to the committee amendments?

SENATOR KEYES: The amendments that I have up there, is that to the committee amendments or is that an amendment to the bill? I think it is to the committee amendment, isn't it?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, your amendment does not go to the committee amendments so you want to wait until we complete the committee amendments?

SENATOR KEYES: I believe so. I will wait and put it on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, do you wish to speak to the committee amendments or do you want to speak to the bill as a whole? Senator Labeledz, the bill as a whole? Okay, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended to LB 164. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the committee amendments as amended are adopted. And now we have Senator Keyes' amendment to the bill as a whole.
