CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment #1 is adopted. Now have you got amendment #2?

CLERK: I have some other amendments by Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I would like to withdraw that second amendment for the time being at least. I may resubmit it but not at this point.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Unanimous consent is asked to withdraw the amendments. Are there any other amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes. Senator Keyes, we are working on LB 65. We have adopted one amendment.

SENATOR KEYES: Which amendment is that?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment that was found on page 884.

SENATOR KEYES: Is that the one that has to do with the multiple amputees or is this the one that has to do with veterans?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR KEYES: You are on LB 65, yes?

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are on LB 65 and we have adopted one amendment.

SENATOR KEYES: What did you do with the committee amendments, Senator Carsten?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments have been adopted on General File. We are on Select File. Senator Carsten, would you explain just briefly the amendment we just adopted to LB 65?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Yes. These were amendments that were brought to us by Mr. Cutshall, the bill drafter, that said that this was obsolete material and it was a cleanup package. While we had the statute before us, it was the proper time to do it. It is obsolete material. It is no longer needed.
